

Verification of U.S. Armed Forces Veteran or Chapter 31 Vocational Rehabilitation & Employment Assistance.

Residency Exception for Honorably Discharged Military Personnel Moving to Colorado or Using Chapter 31 VR&E Education Benefits

A **military member** is eligible to apply for in-state tuition using this form if the member was **Honorably Discharged from the Armed Forces** of the United States (i.e., Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or Coast Guard), is not a member of the Colorado National Guard and would not otherwise qualify for in-state tuition as a one-year resident of Colorado.

Individuals using **Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment (VR&E) assistance under Chapter 31** are also eligible to apply for in-state tuition using this form.

Veterans qualifying for in-state tuition on these bases do not qualify for Colorado resident financial aid programs; however, they are eligible to receive the College Opportunity Fund (COF) stipend.

Instructions

Email, fax, mail or hand deliver the following required documentation to the Office of the Registrar by the end of the fourth week of the applicable term:

1. This form, completed and signed.
2. A current copy of one of the following to verify current physical presence in Colorado:
 - a. Colorado driver's license
 - b. Colorado lease or home warranty deed
 - c. Colorado vehicle registration
3. If applying for the veteran's residency exception, a copy of the veteran's **member 4 form DD214**, including status of discharge.
4. If receiving benefits under Chapter 31, a copy of **form 28-1905**.
